



Exhibit 2: Clauses Applicable to Purchase Orders Under Federal Contracts

If the Purchase Order involves the acquisition of a commercial item or service (see definition set forth at 48 CFR § 2.101) using funds from a Federal government contract – or funds from a subcontract at any tier relating to a Federal government contract – the following clauses from the Federal Acquisition Regulation (“FAR”) and the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (“DFARS”) are incorporated into the Purchase Order by reference where applicable and form a part of the Standard Terms and Conditions of the Purchase Order. Vendor agrees to flow down all applicable FAR and DFARS clauses to lower-tier subcontractors. Where necessary to make the language of the FAR and DFARS clauses applicable to the Order, the term “contractor” shall mean “Seller,” the term “contract” or “subcontract” shall mean “the Purchase Order,” and the terms “government,” “contracting officer,” and equivalent terms and phrases shall mean “CSHL.”

FAR 52.203-15	Whistleblower Protections Under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Jun 2010) (applies if the subcontract is funded under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act)
FAR 52.203-19	Prohibition on Requiring Certain Internal Confidentiality Agreements or Statements (Jan 2017) (not applicable to personal services agreements with individuals)
FAR 52.204-21	Basic Safeguarding of Covered Contractor Information Systems (Jun 2016) (other than subcontracts for commercially available off-the-shelf items, if flow down is required in accordance with paragraph (c) of FAR clause 52.204-21)
FAR 52.204-23	Prohibition on Contracting for Hardware, Software, and Services Developed or Provided by Kaspersky Lab and Other Covered Entities (Jul 2018)
FAR 52.219-8	Utilization of Small Business Concerns (Nov 2016) ((15 U.S.C. 637(d)(2) and (3)), if the subcontract offers further subcontracting opportunities. If the subcontract (except subcontracts to small business concerns) exceeds \$700,000 (\$1.5 million for construction of any public facility), the subcontractor must include 52.219-8 in lower tier subcontracts that offer subcontracting opportunities.

FAR 52.222-22	Previous Contracts and Compliance Reports (Feb 1999) (applicable where FAR 52.222-26 applies)
FAR 52.222-26	Equal Opportunity (Sep 2016) (not applicable to subcontractors who are awarded less than \$10,000 in the aggregate over a 12-month period)
FAR 52.222-35	Equal Opportunity for Veterans (Oct 2015) (applies to subcontracts of \$150,000 or more unless exempted by the rules, regulations, or orders of the Secretary of Labor)
FAR 52.222-36	Equal Opportunity for Workers with Disabilities (Jul 2014) (applies to subcontracts in excess of \$15,000 unless exempted by the rules, regulations, or orders of the Secretary)
FAR 52.222-37	Employment Reports on Veterans (Feb 2016) (applies to subcontracts of \$150,000 or more unless exempted by the rules, regulations, or orders of the Secretary of Labor)
FAR 52.222-40	Notification of Employee Rights Under the National Labor Relations Act (Dec 2010) (applies to non-exempt subcontracts wholly or partially performed in the U.S. with a value of \$10,000 or more)
FAR 52.222-50	Combating Trafficking in Persons (Mar 2015)
FAR 52.222-55	Minimum Wages Under Executive Order 13658 (Dec 2015) (applies to all subcontracts, regardless of dollar value, that are subject to the Service Contract Labor Standards statute or the Wage Rate Requirements (Construction) statute, and are to be performed in whole or in part in the United States)
FAR 52.222-62	Paid Sick Leave Under Executive Order 13706 (Jan 2017) (applies to all subcontracts, regardless of dollar value, that are subject to the Service Contract Labor Standards statute or the Wage Rate Requirements (Construction) statute, and are to be performed in whole or in part in the United States)
FAR 52.224-3	Privacy Training (Jan 2017) (applicable when subcontractor employees will–(1) have access to a system of records; (2) create, collect, use, process, store, maintain, disseminate, disclose, dispose, or otherwise handle personally identifiable information; or (3) design, develop, maintain, or operate a system of records.)
FAR 52.225-26	Contractors Performing Private Security Functions Outside the United States (Oct 2016) (applies to subcontracts that will be performed outside the United States in areas of combat operations or other significant military operations upon agreement by the Secretaries of Defense and State that the clause applies in that area)
FAR 52.232-40	Providing Accelerated Payments to Small Business Subcontractors (Dec 2013) (applies only to subcontracts with small business concerns)
FAR 52.244-6	Subcontracts for Commercial Items (Jul 2018)
FAR 52.247-64	Preference for Privately Owned U.S.-Flag Commercial Vessels (Feb 2006) (applies if required in accordance with paragraph (d) of FAR clause 52.247-64)

DFARS 252.215-7010	Requirements for Certified Cost or Pricing Data and Data Other Than Certified Cost or Pricing Data (Jan 2018) (applies to subcontracts exceeding the simplified acquisition threshold)
DFARS 252.219-7004	Small Business Subcontracting Plan (Test Program) (Apr 2018) (applies to contracts that offer subcontracting possibilities, are expected to exceed \$700,000 (\$1.5 million for construction of any public facility), and are required to include FAR 52.219-8, Utilization of Small Business Concerns)
DFARS 252.223-7008	Prohibition on Hexavalent Chromium (Jun 2013) (applies to all subcontracts, including subcontracts for commercial items, that are for supplies, maintenance and repair services, or construction materials)
DFARS 252.225-7009	Restriction on Acquisition of Certain Articles Containing Specialty Metals (Oct 2014) (with the exception of paragraphs (d) and (e)(1), this clause applies to all subcontracts for items containing specialty metals to the extent necessary to ensure compliance of end products)
DFARS 252.225-7013	Duty-Free Entry (May 2016) (applies to subcontracts for qualifying country components or nonqualifying country components for which the duty is expected to exceed \$200 per unit)
DFARS 252.225-7048	Export-Controlled Items (June 2013)
DFARS 252.226-7001	Utilization of Indian Organizations, Indian-Owned Economic Enterprises, and Native Hawaiian Small Business Concerns (Sep 2004) (applies to subcontracts exceeding \$500,000)
DFARS 252.227-7015	Technical Data–Commercial Items (Feb 2014) (applies when any technical data related to commercial items developed in any part at private expense will be obtained from the subcontractor for delivery to the Government)
DFARS 252.227-7037	Validation of Restrictive Markings on Technical Data (Sep 2016) (applies to subcontracts requiring the delivery of technical data)
DFARS 252.229-7011	Reporting of Foreign Taxes – U.S. Assistance Programs (Sep 2005) (applies to subcontracts for commodities exceeding \$500)
DFARS 252.235-7002	Animal Welfare (Dec 2014) (applies to subcontracts involving use of live vertebrate animals)
DFARS 252.235-7004	Protection of Human Subjects (Jul 2009) (applies to subcontracts involving human subject research, but does not apply to the use of cadaver materials)
DFARS 252.236-7013	Requirement for Competition Opportunity for American Steel Producers, Fabricators, and Manufacturers (Jun 2013) (applies to any subcontract that involves the acquisition of steel as a construction material)
DFARS 252.239-7010	Cloud Computing Services (Oct 2016) (applies to subcontracts that involve or may involve cloud services)
DFARS 252.244-7000	Subcontracts for Commercial Items and Commercial Components (DOD Contracts) (Jun 2013)
DFARS 252.246-7003	Notification of Potential Safety Issues (Jun 2013) (applies to subcontracts for critical safety item parts; systems and subsystems, assemblies, and subassemblies integral to a system; or repair, maintenance, logistics support or overhaul services for systems and subsystems, assemblies, subassemblies, and parts integral to a system)
DFARS 252.246-7007	Contractor Counterfeit Electronic Part Detection and Avoidance System (Aug 2016) (applies to subcontracts that involve provision of electronic parts or assemblies containing electronic parts)
DFARS 252.246-7008	Sources of Electronic Parts (May 2018) (applies to subcontracts, including subcontracts for commercial items, that are for electronic parts or assemblies containing electronic parts, unless the subcontractor is the original manufacturer)
DFARS 252.247-7003	Pass-Through of Motor Carrier Fuel Surcharge Adjustment to the Cost Bearer (Jun 2013) (applies to all subcontracts with motor carriers, brokers, or freight forwarders)
DFARS 252.247-7023	Transportation of Supplies by Sea (Apr 2014) (applies to certain subcontracts involving transportation of supplies by sea)
DFARS 252.247-7024	Notification of Transportation of Supplies by Sea (Mar 2000) (applies to certain subcontracts involving transportation of supplies by sea)
